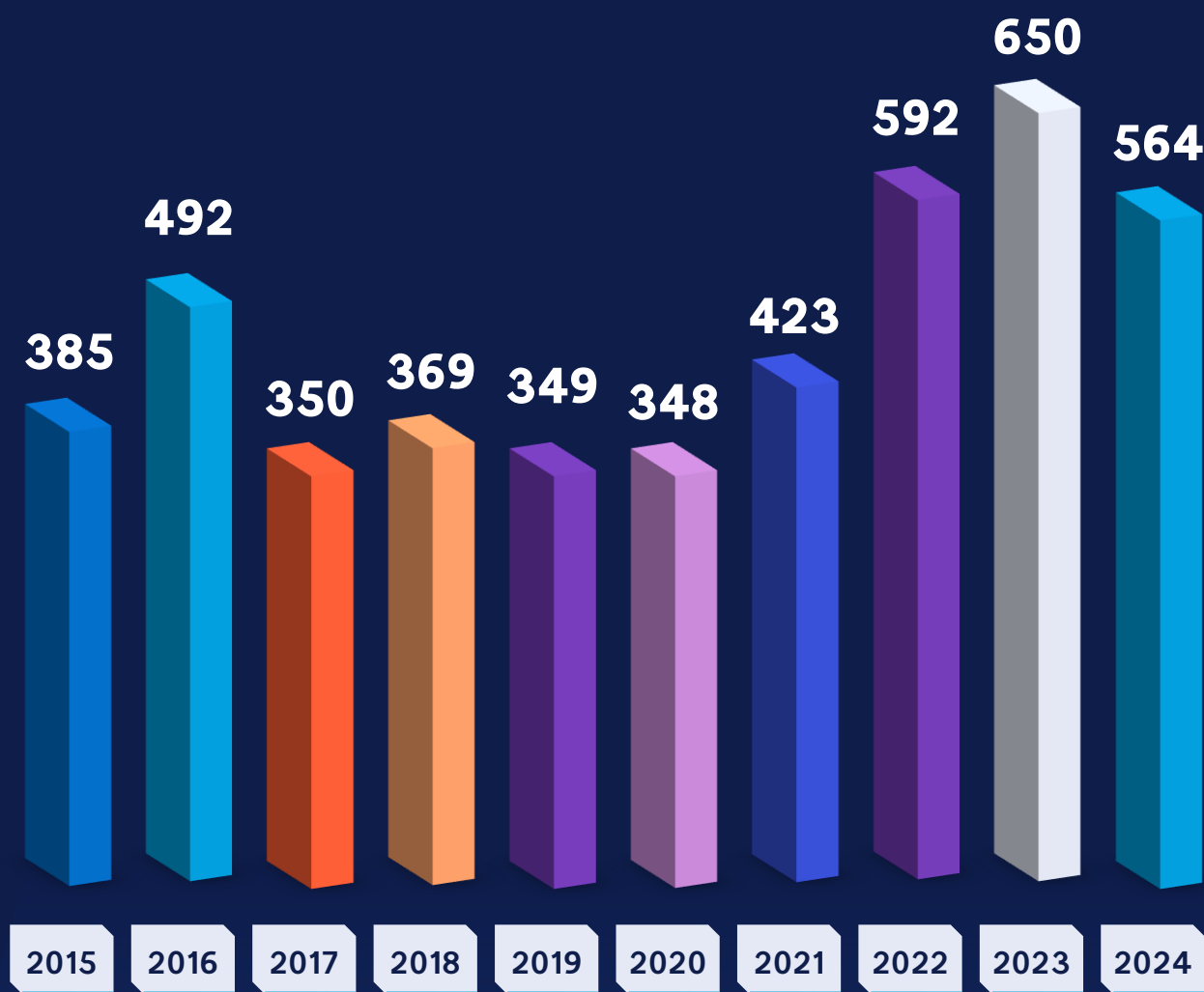

The rising number of global searches about Saudi Arabia reflects growing international interest in the Kingdom. This interest underscores the critical need for reliable, accessible national sources to counter misinformation and provide an authentic portrayal of the Kingdom.

Sources of News about Saudi Arabia

At the local level

- / Digital channels, such as social media and online news outlets, are the leading sources of news and information for the audience.

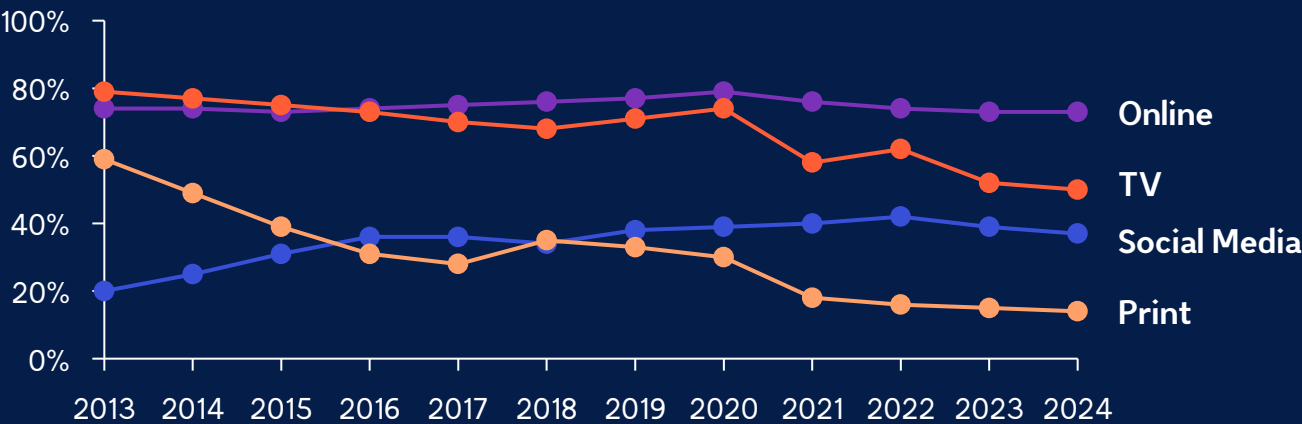
Preferred News Sources (top 3 preferences)

Implications of Relying on Digital Sources

The varying credibility of digital platforms has made them a fertile ground for the spread of misinformation. The ease of publishing and sharing content online makes it challenging for users to distinguish between accurate and false information, particularly regarding the Kingdom’s economic and social transformations. This gives rise to several risks, including:



Decline of Public Confidence



- Misinformation erodes public confidence in official institutions and reputable media outlets, fostering an atmosphere of doubt and uncertainty around circulating information.



Saturation of the Media Landscape



- The spread of conflicting information clutters the media space, hindering the clear and effective dissemination of official and educational messages to the public.



Negatively Influencing Public Opinion



- The amplification of misleading news distorts the public’s understanding of events and policies, which influences public opinion and undermines the development and progress efforts.

The rapid growth of internet access and social media has made it easier for false information and rumors to spread. As the figure shows, most people (84%) think this has a big impact on how exposed people are to misinformation

A Global Look at Creating National References

International Platforms for Disseminating Reliable Information

Amid the growing spread of misinformation, it became increasingly important to establish national platforms that provide accurate and reliable content. These platforms and initiatives have proven their cultural and social value, offering models that could inform the development of a comparable national data source. Among the most notable examples are:



Canada

A government platform with a collection of over **25,000** articles and **26,000** images and videos. It attracts **14.5** million visitors annually and serves as a trusted source of information, covering intellectual, cultural, tourism, and historical topics.



Finland

A platform created by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland and published by the Finland Promotion Board. It offers a comprehensive portrayal of the country, its culture, and its people and receives over **2.5** million visitors annually.



Estonia

An official platform managed by Enterprise Estonia. It features information about the political system, economy, education, and digital services, with an average of **300,000** visitors annually.



Colombia

Colombia's official website, **CO COLOMBIA**, is jointly managed by the government and the private sector. It offers content across 12 themes to counter stereotypes and promote national identity and receives over **1.2** million visits annually.



New Zealand

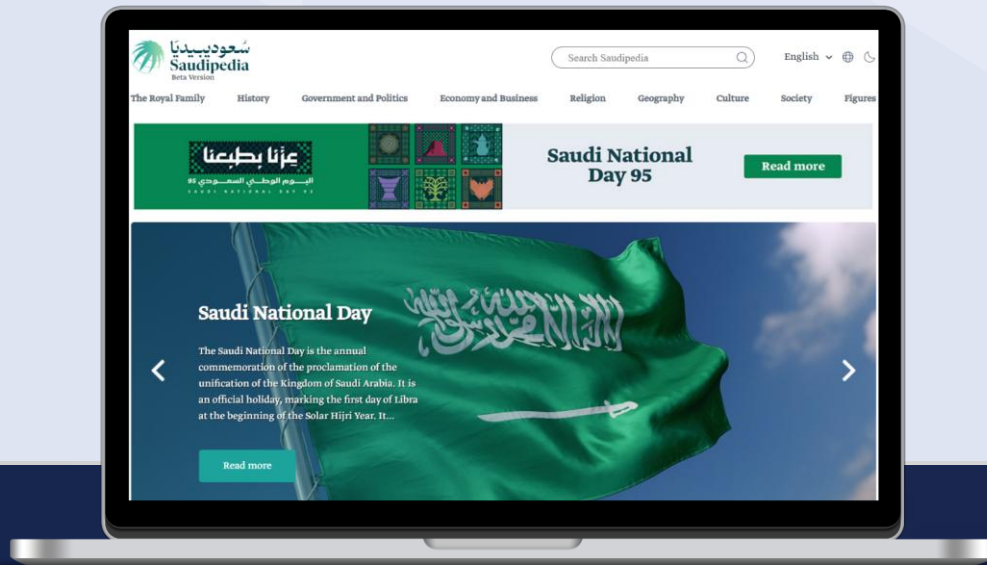
Attracting over **6** million visitors annually, this platform is dedicated to highlighting national history, dispelling cultural and historical misconceptions between communities, and fostering positive social interaction.



South Korea

The Encyclopedia of Korean Culture is managed by the Academy of Korean Studies. It offers expert-authored articles and is continuously updated to reflect new developments. It receives over **16.4** million visitors annually.

Key Advantages of Establishing a Trusted National Data Source



Combatting Misinformation



National data platforms combat misinformation by consolidating verified content into a single, accessible source, thereby curbing the spread of false claims.

Raising Public Awareness



These platforms help raise public awareness by highlighting the country's achievements, heritage, and prominent figures, thereby fostering a sense of national pride and belonging.

Building a More Informed and Engaged Society



These platforms contribute to building a more informed society by providing reliable educational and research resources for students, researchers, and the public. This fosters a deeper understanding of national issues and enhances community engagement.

Supporting Cultural Preservation



These platforms help preserve national heritage by documenting cultural and historical traditions for both present and future generations, while ensuring broad access to this information.

Saudipedia addresses critical information challenges by unifying knowledge, countering misinformation, and presenting an authentic cultural narrative

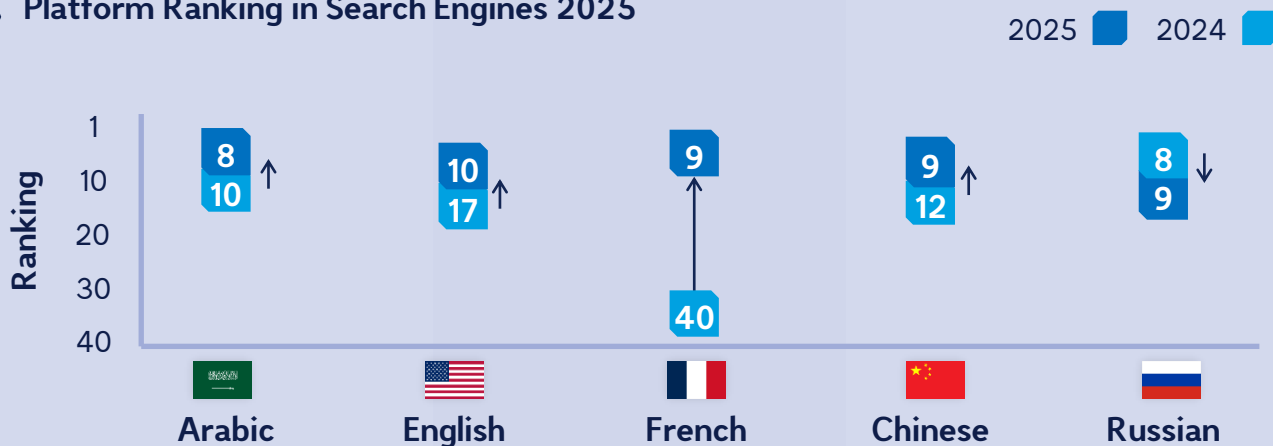


- During 2025, Saudipedia saw increased traffic across all language versions.
- Arabic and English recorded the highest number of visits while French, Chinese, and Russian showed remarkable growth – demonstrating the platform’s wide reach and the audience’s ongoing engagement.

AI-Friendly Content Architecture


 Through strategic SEO initiatives, Saudipedia has enhanced its visibility across major search engines like Google and Bing.


 This has helped to establish the platform’s credibility, aiming to position it as a primary source of information about Saudi Arabia.

 These efforts focus on optimizing for keywords, building high-quality backlinks, and refining site architecture to enhance visibility and search engine rankings.

SEO Optimization

 The platform aims to enhance its presence and visibility to AI tools like (ChatGPT) and (Gemini) by organizing its data and facilitating its seamless flow.

 A core priority for the platform is to facilitate the automated processing of its content.

 The platform ensures that these AI tools consistently refer to Saudipedia’s accurate and credible information when answering questions about the Kingdom.

As Saudi Arabia’s media sector continues to grow, Saudipedia is solidifying its position as a national leading source of data on the Kingdom’s history, current developments and future aspirations.
